ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCILS, CABINETS AND COMMITTEES

The Superintendent may establish councils, cabinets, and committees, as he/she deems necessary for assuring staff participation in decision making and for advice on implementing policies and regulations. Such groups will exercise no inherent authority. Authority for establishing policy remains with the School Committee and authority for implementing policy remains with the Superintendent.

The membership, composition and responsibilities of administrative councils, cabinets and committees will be defined by the Superintendent and may be changed at his/her discretion. However, the Superintendent shall report to the School Committee on the establishment and dissolution of these groups as well as their membership and purpose. The Superintendent shall report periodically to the School Committee on the activities of these groups.

When approved in advance by the <u>School Committee Superintendent</u>, expenses incurred by these councils, cabinets and committees for consultative services, materials, and any investigative travel will be paid by the school district.
