	As you may recall the NASHOBA Regional School Committee identified significant space, condition of building and academic program needs at the district's high school in 2012 and applied for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority to help to address these needs. Unfortunately, our collective effort to communicate effectively what these needs were in the time frame we had was not enough and the opportunity to support the grant through a local matching bond failed.
