School Choice (Protocol)

The Nashoba Regional School Committee recognizes that the following Protocol is established to determine the number of school choice students accepted on an annual basis.

At grades K-12

- A maximum of twenty five (25) school choice students per grade, district wide will be allowed.

At grades K-8

By March 1 of each year the Superintendent will identify the number of school choice seats available within the district using the following guidelines

- The number of homerooms will be established using the class size guidelines listed below.
- A buffer of two (2) seats per homeroom will be left available for students moving into the district.
- A maximum of five (5) new school choice students will be invited per grade, per town, per year if room allows.
- A maximum of ninety six (96) total students per grade, per town.
- All in district students will have the option to attend all day, or half day, kindergarten in another town in the district, if unavailable in their town, before a seat is opened up for a school choice student
