Goals, Evidence and Activities for 2014 - 2015

Goals

By April 2015 NASHOBA will be a Level I School District (I, II, III, IV)

Baseline: Currently a Level II District

- There will be a 5 point increase in Aimsweb scores in Literacy and Math in each grade
- The a middle school ELA prompts will average a 4/6
- 90 % or more parents will report favorably about students' quality of education

By April 2015 NASHOBA will have a long range plan for 100% of the deficiencies in space, technology and educational programming at our high school (I, II,III, IV)

Baseline: Currently only two studies (2008, 2012), but no definitive action plan

By April 2015 NASHOBA 100% of the students will graduate within their cohort group (I,III,IV)

Baseline: Currently 98% graduate within their cohort group.
