Rationale: Honor Roll is recognition of effort and results for students who meet achievement goals that are challenging and rigorous.

This is the proposed Honor Roll methodology for all students in grades 6 -12. All courses will count toward the middle school honor roll. It will be noted for each quarter (at the high school) and at the end of each trimester at the middle schools. High school will use a weighted GPA. All high school course will be eligible for consideration for honor roll.

Methodology:

1. Students on the honor roll:

High Honors	(88 - 94.9)	3.75 ↑	(No C, D, F, or Inc)

- 2. Honor Roll is for grades 6 -12.
- 3. Final grades of each course taken.
- 4. Students must have an "M" for MEETS or "I" for INCONSISTENTLY MEETS under Social Behavior and Work Habits to be considered eligible. (Middle School Only)
- 5. Middle School related arts courses/specials are averaged in as a single course.

We are sharing with the school committee, the school councils and will be soliciting feedback and a final recommendation will be given in September.
