Consultation Services:

Who Are We?

The PACE (Personalized Academics and Career Exploration) Program is a substantially separate program that serves students who are in grades 9-12 and who have special education needs that require intervention in functional areas.

Students focus on developing selfawareness and self-advocacy skills. Students participate in a variety of activities with their grade-level peers, culminating in graduation ceremonies at the end of 12th grade or completion of high school requirements.



Key Goals of Our Program:

This program provides an individualized approach in the education and development of functional skills in the areas of self-help, independent living skills, social interactions, communication, prevocational skills, and functional academics.

Inclusion opportunities are provided based upon students' goals, skill levels, and interests. The program also provides community-based experiences as we believe these are an essential part of students' educational experience to promote the development of independence.



Services We Provide:

We provide services based on individual student's needs. Accommodations we provide include assistive technology, organizational training, voice output, and social skills development apps.

We utilize varying levels of ABA methodologies as prescribed by students' needs; which include discrete trial training, functional behavioral assessments, FAIR plans, positive behavioral supports and naturalized environment training.

In addition, our program provides a specialized Health class specifically designed for students' developmental levels, which focus upon topics related to nutrition, hygiene, body systems, and bodily functions, fitness and human growth and development. In addition, we provide education regarding puberty and interpersonal relationships.
