Who are we and what are the goals of our program.

The Transitions Program is a substantially separate program that serves students who have completed four years of high school who have special education needs that require intervention in functional areas.

This program provides assistance in the development of functional skills and in the areas of self-help, adaptive daily living (ADL) skills, social interactions, communication, and basic academic concepts. Integration opportunities and community-based and job exploratory experiences are an essential part of these students' education to assist in the development of independence. Students will focus on creating their own plan for the future, identifying transitional goals and developing skills in self-advocacy.
